



Payment Guidelines for Patricia A. Haberman DDS, PC

As a patient in our practice, you should expect comprehensive dental care using only the highest quality materials and technology appropriate for your needs. We are committed to providing you with up-to-date information and educational tools so that you can participate in maintaining your oral health. We understand that although cost should not be the determining factor in your health care, it is part of decision making process. This financial agreement is intended to facilitate your ability to achieve the care that you need.

Payment for services is expected at the time of treatment. Our practice accepts cash, personal checks, MasterCard, Visa and Discover. All charges incurred are your responsibility. If you have dental insurance we will process your claim for you. This is a courtesy that we extend as your insurance policy is an agreement among you, your employer and the insurance carrier. If you choose, you may direct your insurance company to pay benefits directly to us by signing the authorization on the Assignment of Benefits Agreement. We will estimate the amount not covered by your benefits and that amount is payable at the time of treatment. This payment will be adjusted as necessary after reconciliation of the insurance payment.

When extensive dental care is needed, we will do our best to ensure that your time and financial investments are clear before treatment begins. Extended payment financing may be available for you.

If there is a balance on your account older than ninety days, collection fees and finance charges of 1.5% per month (18% annually) may be assessed.

There is a charge for missed appointments and for appointments that are not cancelled with 24-hour notice.

It is important to us that financial matters do not disrupt our relationship with you. We are happy to discuss special arrangements as well as any questions you have regarding this agreement.
